## What is Citizen Science?

It is the practice of the **public's participation in scientific research**.



The public can participate in a number of ways, for example by **collecting or monitoring data** for the purposes of a scientific cause or research.



**Climate change**, as one of the most significant threats to humanity, necessitates **everyone's involvement** in climate action.



Citizen Science can empower participants to become active agents of environmental change in their community.



The lack of adequate provisions for the participation of people with disabilities, like the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, makes participation in climate action inaccessible.

## What is Citizen Science 4 All?

Citizen science as a means for social and environmental justice.

CitSci4All centers on the inclusion and active participation of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing community in matters of climate change, as a means of exercising the right to equal participation in societal life.
